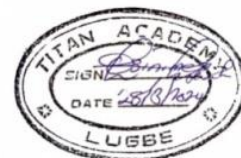

The registration of the above-mentioned examination is ongoing. Parents of JSS 3 students who are yet to pay the exam fee are reminded that late registration attracts an extra fee.

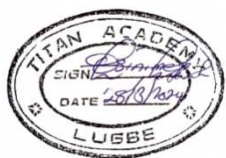
**RESUMPTION**
